AMANDA LORUSSO RECEIVE STOUT EXPERIENCE AWARD

The fund supporting up to two awards annually was created in 2000 in memory of Fred J. Stout Sr., Mt. Carmel, Ill., a lifelong Jersey breeder and member of the Jersey Marketing Service staff from 1978 to 1997. Stout was instrumental in the growth of JMS marketing activities, and later added duties as a type evaluator and in customer field service for the American Jersey Cattle Association (AJCA).

Stout believed that the best learning experiences happen in the everyday world. These awards honor that conviction by providing financial support for a paid internship each year with Jersey Marketing Service.

Amanda is currently working towards a B.S. degree in agriculture business and an A.S. degree in dairy production management from the State University of New York at Cobleskill. She has been a member of the Cobleskill Dairy Cattle Club since 2016 and is a past publicity chair for the Connecticut 4-H Extension Center.

In 2014, Amanda was a member of the Connecticut state dairy judging team that competed at the National FFA Dairy Cattle Judging Contest. She has been an active member of 4-H, serving three years as president of the Elite 4-H Dairy Club. Amanda also served three years as secretary of the Little Town Dairy Farmers 4-H Club.

After graduation from SUNY-Cobleskill, Amanda intends to work with dairy youth programs while continuing to work with the marketing of Registered Jerseys. She also expects to use what she learns from this experience to improve her own herd of Registered JerseysTM.
