2016 JERSEY ALL AMERICANS TO BE CROWNED NOVEMBER 5-7 IN LOUISVILLE

More than \$45,000 offered for three Jersey shows in three days at the Kentucky Exposition Center

October 31, 2016, Reynoldsburg, Ohio—The 64th All American Jersey Show & Sale returns November 5, 6 and 7 to the North American International Livestock Exposition in Louisville, Ky.

Premiums totaling \$45,665 will be awarded in three shows. Last year's All American assembled more than 500 Registered JerseysTM under one roof, making it the largest single-site exhibition of Jerseys in the United States and the world for 2015.

The All American Junior Jersey Show is scheduled for Saturday, November 5. Jeff Brown, Jackson Center, Ohio, will judge with Jenny Thomas, North Lewisburg, Ohio, serving as his consultant. This is one of the richest youth-only shows in the world with premiums totaling \$9,625, plus an additional \$5,000 in exhibitor support provided by the American Jersey Cattle Association.

The 63rd National Jersey Jug Futurity will award premiums of \$9,790 on Sunday, November 6. More than 850 heifers were nominated for the show in 2013, with 46 of them now eligible to compete for the Winner's share of at least \$1,600. They will be judged by Ted DeMent, Kenney, Ill. His consultant will be Amanda Lutz, Chester, S.C.

The open division of The All American Jersey Show is scheduled for Monday, November 7 and will be judged by Mike Berry, Albany, Ore. His consultant will be Jon Kingdon, Warwick Township, Ontario.

The first and second place entries in each class of all shows will be named the All American and Reserve All American winners for 2016 by the American Jersey Cattle Association. The shows will be streamed live from Freedom Hall via webcast at www.livestockexpo.org.

Two sales, both managed by Jersey Marketing Service of Reynoldsburg, Ohio, are scheduled.

The 64th All American Jersey Sale is the premier showcase for Registered JerseyTM genetics in the United States. There are 56 outstanding females and choices slated to sell on Sunday, November 6, plus two high-ranking genomic young sires: Sunset Canyon Maid-Rite-ET, GJPI 201; and Jars of Clay Boaz-ET, GJPI 206.

The 59th Pot O'Gold Sale on Saturday, November 5 will offer 34 genomic-evaluated heifers that can only be purchased by youth between seven and 20 years of age. Presenting Sponsor of the sale is Cow's Match® Jersey Blend from Land O'Lakes Animal Milk Products Co.
