PORTRAIT OF CORE AND WOODRUFF RAISES THOUSANDS FOR CORE JERSEY YOUTH FUND

Reynoldsburg, Ohio, December 19, 2018—Friends, former colleagues, and dairy businesses from across the country joined forces November 4 in Louisville, Ky., to acquire a commissioned portrait depicting Maurice E. Core and auctioneer Merlin Woodruff, the two men who for decades personified The All American Jersey Sale.

Jeff and Alta Mae Core of Salvisa, Ky., commissioned and donated the artwork in honor of their "beloved Uncle Maury," who passed August 29, 2018 just weeks short of celebrating his ninetieth birthday. Proceeds were designated for the Maurice E. Core Jersey Youth Fund. The 501(c)(3) permanent trust created in 1993 provides financial support for national Jersey youth activities, primarily at The All American Jersey Show & Sale.

The work rendered in marker pen and color pencil by California artist Gary Sauder was sent for permanent display at the museum of National Dairy Shrine in Fort Atkinson, Wis.

Core started his 37-year career with the American Jersey Cattle Club in May of 1956 and took charge as coordinator for The All American Show and Sale in 1959. Until his retirement as Executive Secretary in 1993, he remained involved in the All American. His words of encouragement to junior members over five decades are among the memories many Jersey breeders now have of the All American events they participated in during their youth.
