Market Update

Block cheddar cheese is priced above barrels for the first time since early February. Blocks closed the week out at \$1.47, up a penny from last week, on 13 loads traded. Barrels dropped \$0.45 to \$1.4425 on 23 sales. Grade AA butter picked up \$0.02 to \$2.8225 on 8 truckloads. Nonfat dry milk lost \$0.0075 at \$1.1625 on 11 loads traded. Whey gained an impressive \$0.035 to \$0.4450.

In futures markets Class III contracts average \$17.04/cwt. for March through August, while Class IV contracts average \$20.19 for the same six months.

Dairy Margin Coverage 2024

The enrollment period for 2024 Dairy Margin Coverage is currently open and closes April 29th. A revision to the 2024 program allows eligible herds to make a one-time adjustment to established production history.

According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture Economic Research Service, consumption of American cheese was down 4.2% to 460.5 million pounds. Other-than-American cheese was down 2% to 656.8 million pounds, and total consumption of cheese picked up 2.9% at 1.117 billion pounds. Butter jumped up 10.5% from last year at 170.8 million pounds, and dry whey picked up 2.5% to 50 million pounds. Finally, consumption of nonfat dry milk and skim milk powder combined rose 9% to 61.6 million pounds.

U.S. Dairy Exports

Total dairy exports for January 2024 reached 449 million pounds, a 3.7% decrease from 2023. Nonfat dry milk and skim milk powder combined, the United States' top dairy export for this period, dropped 14% to 129.3 million pounds. Total cheese picked increased 12.6% to 84 million pounds. There were 29.8 million pounds of dry whey exported in January, a 2.9% gain from the prior year. Whey protein concentrate picked up 4.1% to 25.6 million pounds, whole milk powder picked up 6.3% to 2.6 million pounds, and butter dropped 33.1% to 5 million pounds.

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
