2018-19 Scholarships and Educational Awards

Jack C. Nisbet Memorial Scholarship (\$2,500)

Eligibility: Awarded to an eligible candidate in the 2017 National Jersey Youth Achievement Contest.

V. L. Peterson Scholarship (\$2,500)

Eligibility: Students who have completed at least one year of college work.

Paul Jackson Scholarship (\$2,000)

Eligibility: Students who have completed at least one year of college work.

William A. Russell Memorial Scholarship (\$2,500)

Eligibility: High school graduate accepted into a college or university program for the fall of 2018 (*i.e., entering college freshman*).

Cedarcrest Farms Scholarship (\$2,250)

Eligibility: Undergraduate or graduate student enrolled in a program to earn a degree in large animal veterinary practice, dairy production, dairy manufacturing, or dairy product marketing, and who demonstrates through completed coursework and goal statement, significant progress toward this intended degree and a clear intention for a career in agriculture.

Russell-Malnati Scholarship for Advanced Studies (\$5,000)

Eligibility: Graduate student seeking degrees in dairy science, animal science, large animal veterinary practice, dairy production, dairy manufacturing or dairy product marketing.

Bob Toole Youth Award (\$2,000)

Eligibility: High school graduate for (a) college expenses or (b) a clearly defined practical educational experience related to breeding, developing and showing Registered Jerseys™.

AJCA Directors' Scholarship (\$2,250)

Eligibility: Academic performance, activities and accomplishments with Jersey cattle and commitment to continued involvement in the Jersey dairy business.

Anne E. Perchard Challenge Award (\$350)

Eligibility: Applicant in current year national achievement contest and/or scholarship program to recognize abilities and leadership potential and challenges the recipient to achieve his/her potential through continuing Jersey activities.

Morris B. Ewing ABS Genetic Performance Scholarship (\$3,000)

Eligibility: Junior or senior undergraduate student seeking a career in genetics, dairy production, large animal veterinary medicine or milk marketing.

The Lineweaver Scholarship (\$3,000, eligibility for renewal by previous year's recipient determined May 15)

Eligibility: Students who have completed at least one year at an accredited four-year college/university in a dairy, animal sciences or dairy products department, based on financial need, leadership skills, and academic performance.

Fred Stout Experience Awards (\$5,500, two awards of \$2,750)

Eligibility: High school graduates. To be used for travel, housing, and other expenses for employer-paid internships, one with Jersey Marketing Service, Reynoldsburg, Ohio, and the other an on-farm, customized experience on a Jersey dairy operation.

Reuben R. Cowles Youth Award (varies)

Eligibility: Jersey owners from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia who are at least high school seniors but not older than 36 years of age.
